BCASWI Accomplishments:

- 1. Contractor Registration Act
 - First in 50 years.
 - 15,960 registered (approximate)
- 2. Notice and Opportunity to Repair Act
 - Definition: Let builder fix before you sue
- 3. Building Codes
 - Code Board now has one more contractor
 - Changed how codes are adopted
 - Negotiated using the 2009 residential building & energy code in lieu of the 2012

- 4. Fire Sprinklers
 - Negotiated keeping fire sprinklers from being mandated in single family residences and duplexes.
- 5. Helped establish Community Infrastructure Districts
 - Mechanism that would allow developers to prepay impact fees or finance impact fee eligible infrastructure with Bonding secured by property tax.

- to immediately discontinue use of all BCASWI, IBCA and NAHB trade insignias and materials if, for any reason, I am deemed not to be a member in good standing of BCASWI.
